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Background

- NCODA Legislative Affairs began in December of 2020
- Legislative & Policy Advisory Committee (LPAC) held first meeting in January of 2021
- 2021 Fall Summit was our first legislative session
 - Arkansas Attorney Generals Office highlighted a panel focused on PBM reform
- Legislative Affairs team has one goal in mind; To be the primary educational resource for all things in the legislative oncology space

Methods

- Commenting on issues that matter to patients, physicians, pharmacists, nurses and all oncology staff
 - By the end of 2022 LPAC will have released 40+ statements on issues including but not limited to PBM and Co Pay Reform, White/Brown/Clear Bagging, Access to Quality Care and more
- Virtual Content; Webinars, Round Tables, Podcasts and Social Media posts
- Out-reach to practice leaders
- Collaboration with various same-minded committees and groups to ensure quality care for cancer patients through the legislative process
